The 8th Grade class will be having a car wash fundraiser on October 14 at the Arizona Conference office from 11:30 am - 12:45 pm.

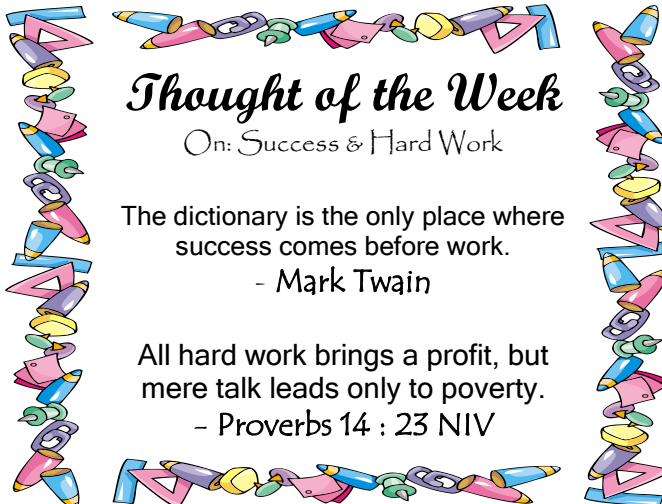
